- Minimum 6 years Montessori Lead Teaching experience
- Excellent communication and community-building skills
- An ability to articulate the importance of stewardship, with tangible evidence of his/her ability to foster continuity and momentum within a program to support a strong relationship between school health and culture.
- Administrative and/or supervisory experience is preferred
- Experience working with children with various learning differences
- An eagerness to support families in their own development as it relates to child-rearing and school's mission, values, and pedagogical practice
