RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for maintaining a clean and orderly environment and keeping track of supplies allocated to the Extended Day Program
- Preparation, service and cleanup of daily snack
- Responsible for the facilitation of activities, classroom management and the modeling of conflict resolution when disagreements arise
- Ability to effectively communicate with parents regarding their child's participation in the Extended Day Program
- Prompt arrival and excellent attendance are crucial. Any anticipated tardiness or illness must be reported to the Business Office Manager as soon as possible so that appropriate staffing of the program is assured
- Ability to lift 50 pounds from ground to chest
- Maintain confidentiality in alignment with the school's policies and procedures
