Consultation with classroom teachers and families is integral to the successful work of this individual as he/she helps students apply academic achievement strategies and manage emotions while applying interpersonal and intrapersonal skills.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Bachelor's degree or higher preferred, with a focus on school counseling or related field.
- Training must have included practicum, internship, or equivalent in a k-12 school setting as requirements of the degree.
- As applicable, must fulfill continuing education requirements and uphold ASCA ethical and professional standards.
- Minimum two years experience
- Ability to work with both students (3-14) and adults on campus in a productive and respectful manner.
- Demonstrate an interest, background and knowledge base of but not limited to the following:
 - Montessori education
 - ASCA standards
 - Child Development
 - Social & Emotional Development

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Implement a comprehensive school counseling program according to ASCA standards
- Provide short-term counseling to students for academic, social, or emotional concerns
- Guide students to identify and apply solutions to their academic, social, or emotional problems
- Create and facilitate group and peer support options for students
- Refer students and families to mental health resources for long-term support
- Deliver a relevant guidance curriculum based on student developmental needs and student standards from the ASCA Mindsets & Behaviors for Student Success
- Advise and appraise individual student academic planning and goal setting
- Share information with families about the position of School Counselor for Learning and Student Support
- Share appropriate information to support student success and growth with faculty and parents

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- Collaborate with families, teachers, administrators, and the community to support student success
- Consult with teachers about classroom management, student success, and the role of noncognitive factors in behavioral or academic difficulties
- Consult with administration to identify and resolve student issues and needs based on academic, attendance, and discipline data
- Maintain a list of community resources to support student learning and development for referral to faculty and parents
- Be a consistent advocate for all students
- Assess student abilities, interests, and achievement to guide student and family decisions regarding education after MOMI
- Facilitate and mediate interactions between parents, teachers, and students
- Analyze student success, growth, and needs
- Use student data to identify achievement/opportunity gaps and develop student outcome goals
- Apply student data to the development of guidance lessons and actions plans
- Assess effectiveness of school counselor and counseling program and adjust as needed
- Apply all legal and ethical principles of the school counseling profession
- Maintain accurate records
- Protect confidentiality of student records and information according to state and federal regulations
- Attend and/or lead applicable school program meetings and events
